Drive by Congregation Beth David to pick up your ***Machzor To-Go Bag***. There's no need to get out of your car to receive your package. The Machzor you receive will be numbered and checked out to you. You can also pick up your SLOTY Holiday Bag if you ordered one.

Returning your Machzor: Please take extra special care of your Machzor on loan. (No folding pages, marking on text, or eating while using it.) Return your Machzor within one week of Yom Kippur to the addresses on the bag or to the Congregation Beth David office. Replacement cost for a Machzor is \$45.00.
